






Osteoarchaeology Field Course



This intensive field course will introduce the basic tenets of osteoarchaeology and give students hands-on training and the ability to identify, document, analyze and interpret human skeletal remains.

Archaeological human bone assemblages from Kaman Kalehöyük housed at the Japanese Institute of Anatolian Archaeology research facilities in Kaman, Kırşehir will be extensively used during integrated lectures and hands-on laboratory activities to address methodological and theoretical issues that are significant in designing and carrying out osteoarchaeological research.

Topics covered will include skeletal identification, biological profile estimation, paleopathology and trauma analysis.

This field course is open to all students and prior experience in osteology is not required.

Instruction will be in English.

Location:

The field course is located at the Japanese Institute of Anatolian Archaeology near Kaman, in Kırşehir Province, central Turkey. (<http://www.jiaa-kaman.org/en/>)

The JIAA excavates the archaeological sites Kaman-Kalehöyük, Yassıhöyük and Büklükale from their headquarters, which includes extensive labs, a museum, a Japanese garden and residential facilities.

It can be reached by an hourly bus (1.5 to 2 hours) from Ankara Otogar (AŞTİ) to Kaman.

Details:

A course fee of \$300 applies including accommodation and food at the JIAA residence.

Participants will need to arrange their own travel to Kaman and should arrive at the JIAA on the evening of July 19th and arrange to depart on July 26th.
